

# **Student Feedback on Course Evaluations**



Misunderstanding of the difference between signed & unsigned evaluations


Lack of awareness about how evaluations make a difference

Possible fear of completing evaluations

Questions on the evaluation may not pertain to the course completed

Timing of the course evaluation may make it difficult to complete

Students may be unaware that student responses to evaluations may not be shared beyond the professor until they undergo peer review/tenure review
